### Q: Why do my appliances fail more often in Fort Worth?

A: Fort Worth's combination of extreme summer heat, high humidity, and mineral-rich water creates a harsh environment for appliances. Refrigerator compressors and dryer heating elements work much harder, while dishwashers and washing machines battle

scale buildup. Regular maintenance from a local technician who understands these specific conditions is key to longevity.

**Q: How quickly can you service my neighborhood?**

**Q: What's the most common summer repair call in Fort Worth?**

A: Refrigerator failures are our top summer emergency. When temperatures soar above 100°F, the unit's compressor must run constantly, leading to overheating and burnout. We also see many dryer repairs, as vents clogged with lint become major fire hazards in the dry heat.

**Q: Can hard water really damage my appliances?**

A: Yes, Fort Worth's water is notoriously hard, meaning it has high mineral content. Over time, this causes limescale to build up inside dishwashers, washing machines, and ice makers, reducing efficiency, causing clogs, and damaging heating elements. We often install water softener bypass kits or perform descaling services.
